Instructions for Submission

Article Structure

1. The Full Paper Manuscripts should be compiled in the following order: title page abstract (250 – 300 words); keywords; main text; acknowledgments; references; Appendixes (as appropriate).
2. The manuscripts submitted should not be of more than 5000 words and typeface: Arial, 12 font size, single line space and should be prepared according to APA, 6th ed., except for the additional requirement of numbering the sections, as described below.
3. Divide your article into clearly defined and numbered sections. Subsections should be numbered as 1.1, 1.2. Section headings should be in bold and italic.
4. The main text should include an i) Introduction - state the objective of the work, research gap, Methodology (avoiding a detailed literature survey or a summary of the results) ii) Results – Results should be clear and concise, iii) Discussion – This should explore the significance of the results of the work. Avoid extensive citations and discussion of published literature iv) Conclusions – The main conclusions of the study may be presented in a short conclusion section, which may stand alone from a subsection of a Discussion or Results and Discussion section. v) Appendices – If there is more than one appendix, they should be identified as A, B etc,
5. Essential title page information should be title, author names and affiliations, Corresponding author, (ensure that the e-mail address is given and the contact details are kept up to date by the corresponding author with present official address and permanent address).

Conference Special Issue Journal

All conference papers will be subjected to double blind review for publication consideration in the special issue of the **Journal of Finance and Business Studies (JFBS)** and **Journal of Innovation and Social Science Research (JISSR)**.
