It is now the largest institution in the country for imparting Home Science Education at all levels. It was one of the eight colleges on which autonomy was conferred by the University of Madras in June 1978 and the first of women's colleges to get this distinction. The institute has been recognised by UGC u/s. 12B and has been re-accredited with A+ grade by NAAC. The institute functions under seven schools namely School of Home Science, School of Physical Science & Computational Science, School of Biosciences, School of Arts & Social Science, School of Commerce & Management, School of Engineering and School of Education.
