5	12.08.2013		The NSS Cell of our University conducted an Awareness Programme on Breast Feeding as a part of the International Breast Feeding Week observed every year during the first week of August. As part of the awareness programme, a total of around 700 volunteers participated from our university in the rally organised to sensitize the public on awareness regarding the importance of breast feeding. One hundred volunteers of NSS unit II accompanied by NSS Programme and Assistant Programme Officers participated in the rally. The volunteers held placards and shouted slogans on the importance of breast feeding. We covered the residential areas along Bharathi Park Road, moved on to NSR road which is a busy business area and came out through Mettupalayam Road to our university. 6	17.08.2013	Visit to Bharathiyar University, Coimbatore, for TATA Expo	<p>150 NSS Volunteers and two Programme Officers of unit II visited the TATA Expo which consisted of 60 stalls put up physically and mentally challenged special people and NGOs working among them. There were stalls by Cure Club Foot, Tamil Nadu where special stores and gadgets to cure club foot were displayed. All the stalls were having pamphlets and literature with contact numbers /helpline/website to access them for help.</p> <p>There were also various flexes displaying all the specially training as well as the helpful activity done by various organisations for those disabled students They are not disabled , they are differently abled students , that can be evidently seen from the EXPO .</p> <p>There were people from Voice tech India and Tiger DRS explaining about the researched, user-friendly, dedicated and the state of art AAC software and hardware devices. They explained us about those devices which can be effectively used in training or improve communication in persons with speech problems like include CP, Hearing impairment , Mental retardation ,Autism, ADHD and other neurological conditions. We saw many equipments as well as development in technology for the disability management.</p> <p>We saw various types of hearing aids and gadgets specially meant for people having hearing problems brought by ALPS INTERNATIONAL. There were various equipments like lighting alarm which when attached to door or some other places, which lights when someone hits it. There were also vibrating equipment producing symbol for them to react in particular situation.</p> <p>There were volunteers from Anne's Rehabilitation Institutions for Special Children Empowerment ARISE which is run by sister's of St. Anne which asks for volunteers to come forward to get trained themselves for the disability management. Similarly, there were photos displayed by YMCA group, Madurai which opens special schools for otherwise abled children.</p> <p>Special equipments were displayed for the visually challenged people to learn Braille language to read and write for them. All those Braille boards were also put for display by SPARSH. Sparsh products, such as software for the visually challenged people were also displayed by them. 			<p>engaged in foot and neck massage for pain relief.</p> <p>There were people from Samarthanam trust which distributes the pamphlets and explained us about the various charitable activities done by them. They have done various things for promoting fitness and sporting activities for visually challenged and specially abled people .They are also engaged to empower visually impaired disabled and under privileged people by focusing on educational, social, economic and cultural aspects.</p> <p>People form Shivesh Trust were there to introduce their software BOL, which is special equipment, specially meant to train students suffering from Autism. There were also online teaching facilities as well as online test under Dhakshan organisation for the Autism students. There were also special equipments like pinhole tapper for increasing the concentration power of Autism students.</p> <p>Under Holy Christ Cross Service Society, there is an enterprise named UNICON which is a specially designed Electronic water level controller which prevents overflow. Its indicator will start blinking when water crosses its limit and thus controls water supply. This UNICON institute employs deaf and dumb people. So that it is a source of income generation for them. The working model of the water level controller was also displayed there.</p> <p>There were also many beautiful handicrafts, bangles, wall hanging, jute bags, earrings, glass pots, flower vase, toys, wax and clay models and saplings displayed, specially made by disabled children from star school, Mitra Jyothi, CSI Rehabilitation Centre, Lc Project, Nagapatinam, Tamilnadu Handicapped Federation Trust, Aman Seva Sangam, YMCA, National Trust had given wonderful contribution for the various decorative and handicraft items which was exhibited in stalls for sale. There were people from Shankara Eye Hospital taking volunteers for eye donation. Many of our students took part in the divine activity. Association of People with Disabilities had exhibited a model of wheel chair to explain the usage for easy handling of wheel chair.
