4. Procedure Followed for Grant of Scholarships:

a) For State/Central Government and Non-Government Scholarships

- i. The institute regularly informs the students regarding various scholarships through noticeboards, websites and also the class-tutors makes announcement in the classes.
- ii. The detail of various Scholarship (See Annexure) is provided in the Student's Hand Book also.
- iii. The students approach the Scholarship In-charge in the Admin section and the Student's Affair Dean to collect application form and for further clarifications.
- iv. The filled in forms of the students are checked and duly forwarded by the respective authorities to the concerned organisations for processing.
- v. The students who are awarded scholarships are intimated with the necessary documents.

b) Management Scholarships

- i. The institute regularly informs the students regarding various scholarships through noticeboards, websites and also the class-tutors makes announcement in the classes.
- ii. A total of 21 management scholarship (See Annexure) for financial assistance are provided for eligible students every year.
- iii. The scholarship is awarded to qualified students based their credentials such as academic performance, attendance, financial hardship and track record of good conduct throughout the course period.
- iv. The eligible students submit the scholarship application to the Scholarship In-charge in the Admin section and the Student's Affair Dean every year within the allotted time period.

c) Other Financial Assistance

- i. Tuition fee waiver for SC/ST and economically weaker section is also provided.
- ii. 50% Application Fee Waiver for SC/ST students is provided.
