A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between Avinashilingam Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women, Coimbatore and the University of Reading, Reading, United Kingdom for collaborative research and organizing conferences, workshops and joint training of students, research scholars and staff in the areas of Food Science and Nutrition, Nutrigenetics, Personalized nutrition, Food Service Management and Dietetics, Biochemistry and Biotechnology in 2018 and was renewed on 15th February 2021 for five more years.

Dr. Premavathy Vijayan, Vice Chancellor, Avinashilingam Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women signed the MoU and Dr. Vimal S Karani, Assistant Professor in Nutrigenetics and Personalised Nutrition, Hugh Sinclair Unit of Human Nutrition represented the University of Reading, UK.



A Memorandum of Understanding was signed between Avinashilingam Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women, Coimbatore and Universitas Airlangga, Surabaya, East Java, Indonesia on 27th January 2021 for a period of five years.
