Nevertheless, through this fast paced series of workshops we learnt how to turn a seemingly non-commercial idea into a marketable concept which can have the potential to become a viable, gainful business.

In fact apparently simple questions that made unfamiliar ideas, such us business plan, workflow chart and marketing communication. By urging us to work our ides initially through these questions and by assisting us to define short, medium and long term targets, or chief guest facilitated our thinking towards transforming our preliminary, unrefined ideas into coherent, professional-sounding money-making enterprises.

We were also able to discuss our own business ideas with the group and, indeed, some brilliant ideas were heard. Some of the ideas expressed were a unit which will include an organic farm, a vet clinic and a café in the same premises; a gym/nutrition centre which will have a holistic approach to well being. The sessions were concluded by Mrs.R.Amirtha Priya by thanking him and Presented him a momento. IQAC, Director thanked the organizers.



Report of the Workshop

The two day's workshop was conducted with the broad objective to give an overview about the statistical methods used in research analysis and how different tests of statistics can be used to analyze a given set of data. The specific objective of the program included understanding the sampling methods, choosing appropriate test for testing hypothesis proposed in the research and applying SPSS software for data analysis.

On 25th and 26th October, 2018, the Department of Food science and Nutrition, Nutrition Society of India, Coimbatore chapter and Department of Textiles and Clothing conducted a workshop entitled "Stat is Tricks" in the Hi-Tech seminar hall. The workshop was opened to the 1st year post graduate students of Food Science and Nutrition, Textiles and Clothing and Biotextiles, MPhil. and Ph.D. research scholars. About 75 participants benefitted from the workshop. The workshop was organized by Dr.R.Balasasirekha, Assistant Professor, Department of Food Science and Nutrition and Dr.S.Amsamani, Professor, Department of Textiles and Clothing. The task for the workshop was distributed among the students. Inaugural address was given by Dr. Anil C. Mathew, Professor, Department of Community Medicine, PSG Institute of Medical Sciences and Research, Coimbatore. Dr. Arun, Professor of Community Medicine accompanied Dr. Anil. He gave an overview on "Correlation", its working formula and various examples on the topic which made the participants easier to understand the concept which was discussed earlier in the regular statistics classes. He explained about Pearson correlation coefficient, regression, formulae to compute the problem and interpret the relation found out of it. He also showed how to carry out the analysis of correlation and regression in SPSS. He concluded his session with the statement that correlation measures simple linear relation and does not imply

causation. His take away message was not to be afraid of the statistics and always believe in it. His session was very interesting and interactive. The forenoon session was completed with the vote of thanks by Ms.Madhuri Sinha, I MSc. FSN. Similarly, in the afternon session, the guest speaker Dr. K.T. Geetha, Dean, School of Artsand Social Sciences, Professor of Economics, Avinashilingam Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women, was introduced by Ms. Meenakshi, I M.Sc. Department of Textiles and Clothing. Dr. K.T. Geetha highlighted on the topic "Probability and its applications". She dealt from the scrap with the definition and related words of probability, rules of probability, binomial probability distribution, Poisson distribution, normal distribution and standard normal distribution. Her session was very informative and interactive. The vote of thanks for the afternoon session was given by Ms. Reshma Krishnan, I M.Sc. Department of Food Science and Nutrition.

For the second day, the guest speaker for the session Dr. S. Gandhimati, Professor, Department of Economics, Avinashilingam Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women was introduced by Ms. Shifana, I MSc. FSNHer session included practical overview of SPSS and how to use the SPSS for statistical analysis. She made very clear about using the SPSS and the practical session was very interesting to learn. With the vote of thanks by Ms. Vidhya of I M.Sc. FSN, the forenoon session ended. In the afternoon session, the guest speaker, Dr. G. P. Jeyanthi, Director, Research and Consultancy, Avinashilingam Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women, was introduced by Ms. Sarika Maskara, I MSc. FSN. Dr.G. P. Jeyanthi rocked on"Parametric and Non-Parametric test". She explained about types of statistics, distribution of data, testing of hypothesis using various test like ttest, F-test, Chi-square test and ANOVA. She clarified the concepts- where and in which conditions these test can be applied. She further enlightened about the measurement scale used in statistics. Her in-depth knowledge made clear about the parametric and nonParametric test and its application. The afternoon session ended by the vote of thanks delivered by Ms. Keerthana Sri, I MSc. FSN. The formal closing of the workshop came to end by thanking the administrators and organizers, the professor and head and staff members of both the departments.

To conclude, the one day workshop was really very crucial to get an in-depth knowledge on the statistical method, its application and the use of software for statistical analysis. Every session by the guest speakers were full of information, interactive and interesting. The workshop was very purposive and all the expectations were fulfilled as per mentioned by the participants. Further conduction of such workshops was demanded. IQAC, Director thanked the organizers.

Online Feedback was obtained from all participants to judge the fruitfulness of the workshop and also for further betterment in the conduct of such workshops.




