REPORT ON

The Induction Programme for newly Recruited Faculty Members (10.08.2018)

An Induction Program is aimed to assist the newly recruited Faculty members to become familiar with the culture of the Institute and to develop an understanding of policies and practices at central and local level, to acquire an understanding of how the Institute works and their role contributing to the success of the Institute.

Prof. Dr. K. T. Geetha delivered a talk on “*Curriculum design and teaching learning methods*”

She explained curriculum design and teaching learning methods as process of developing appropriate need-based inputs in consultation with expert groups, and based on the feedback from stakeholders that results in the development of relevant programmes with flexibility, to suit the professional and personal needs of the students and realization of core values. She elaborated about the Key Indicators (KIs) which is considered as the good practices of the institution in initiating a range of programme options and courses that are relevant to the local needs and in tune with the emerging national and global trends. She emphasized Curriculum evolution of the University/Autonomous College by Programme Outcomes (POs), Programme Specific Outcomes (PSOs) and Course Outcomes (COs).

Prof. Dr. K. Manimozhi delivered a talk on “*Assessment and evaluation*”

She delivered a key Indicator issues related to assessment of teaching, learning and evaluative processes and reforms, to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of the system and the specifications are stated as PSOs and COs. She explained about the quality of the assessment process in a HEI depends on how well the examination system actually tests the PSOs and COs, quality of questions, extent of transparency in the system, extent of development-inducing feedback system, regularity in the conduct of examinations and declaration of results as well as regulatory mechanisms for prompt action on possible errors.

Prof. Dr. G. P. Jeyanthi delivered about “*Quality and improvement in research*”

She insisted the faculty to undertake research projects from various funding agencies such as UGC, CSIR, DST, ICSSR, DRDO and UNDP, and encourages its faculty to organize and participate in seminars/workshops and conferences both at national and international levels. She described the infrastructural facilities for research are strengthened by mobilizing resources from

government agencies and 118 sponsored research projects have been executed in the last five years. Impetus for innovation is provided through IPR workshops and research conventions. Forty eight awards for innovations have been received and four patents have been published in the last five years.

Prof. Dr. Udayachandrika explained the importance of “**Infrastructure and learning resources**”

She detailed about teaching-learning, research, and outreach activities of the institute are enhanced by modern and scientific equipments and other support facilities. Smart class rooms, research laboratories, e-learning center, Hi-tech Seminar halls, multimedia and soft-skill laboratories provide impetus for the technology enhanced learning and also Sports infrastructure includes Gymnasia, Basketball, Volley ball, Ball Badminton, Football, Table-tennis courts, athletic tracks and Yoga and Meditation centre.

Also explained the Accessibility to technology enabled education through softwares like JAWS, Kurzweil, ABBYY Fine reader, Win Braille and Dr.Speech for special children. Further she highlighted the important facilities of institute like 24x7 Wi-Fi facilities across both the Campuses with high-speed bandwidth (1GBPS), E-Campus (the e-governance system) for ensuring digitization of all staff and student related activities.

Prof. Dr. N. S. Rohini gave the importance of “**Student Support and Progression**”

She delivered the Facilitating mechanisms like guidance cell, placement cell, grievance redressal cell and welfare measures to support students which are Specially designed inputs for the needy students with learning difficulties. She explained about well-structured, organized guidance and counseling system in our institution. She highlighted the Sustainable good practices which effectively support the students for optimal progression and how Institutional provisions facilitate vertical movement of students from one level of education to the next higher level and/or towards gainful employment.

Prof. Dr. U. Jerinabi addressed on “**Governance, Leadership and Management**”

She explained how the accounts of the Institute are audited internally by a Chartered Accountant appointed by the BoM and externally by the Auditor General, Government of India. She explained the importance of vibrant Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) which plays a crucial role in promoting and sustaining a culture of

excellence oncampus through quality assurance and enhancement strategies that adopts quality management strategies in all academic and administrative aspects. The institution has an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) and adopts a participatory approach in managing its provisions.
