The Communication F.No.10-2/2022 NS -1, dt. 17.12.2023, 04.12.2023 from Ministry of Education, Department of Higher Education has stated the creation of Supernumerary seats in the UGC approved Higher Education Institutions under the **'PM CARES for Children Scheme'**.

With reference to the PM CARE for Children Scheme,

- AICTE reserves two seats per course(Annexure 03)
- Two Supernumerary seats shall be accorded in Institutions(Annexure 04).

<u>*Criteria:*</u> Those children who are issued **'PM CARES Certificate'** shall be eligible for admission. So far nobody with certificate approached us for admission.

Hence, it is recommended that,

- Two seats may be allotted for Engineering courses(AICTE).
- Two seats may be allotted for other courses in general.
