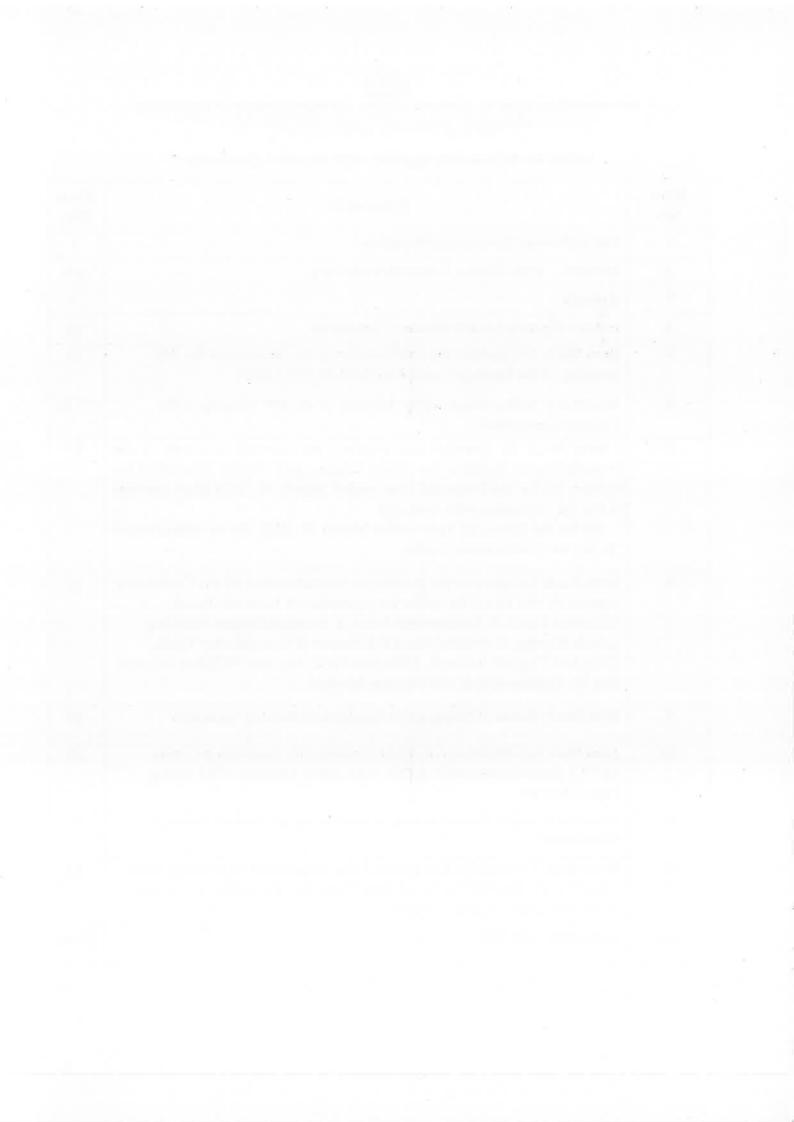

The advertisement for the recruitment of 77 Teaching and 14 Non-Teaching Posts including regular and backlog vacancies under reservation category was published in 'The Hindu' dated 29.12.2021 and also uploaded in the UGC portal on 29.12.2021, adhering to the UGC regulations and reservation norms. The last date for the receipt of the applications was 28.01.2022. Thereafter, the UGC informed vide its Letter No: F.No.1-1/2013(DU) dated 10th June, 2022 that, in view of the spirit of the MoE's letter dated 29.05.2015, there is no justification for recommending the positions due to the financial implication to the UGC /MoE.

The last date for the receipt of the applications was 28.01.2022. 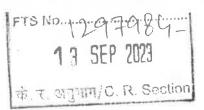

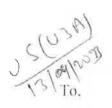

### **Terms & Conditions**

The conditions for undertaking audit of a body or authority at the request of the President or the Governor of a State or the Administrator of a Union Territory having a legislative assembly under Section 20(1) are the following:

- (1) Audit shall be entrusted to the Comptroller and Auditor General if and as agreed to, by the Comptroller and Auditor General.
- (2) The arrangement may be reviewed if requested by the Government or Comptroller and Auditor General.
- (3) The scope, extent and manner of audit shall be decided by the Comptroller and Auditor General.
- (4) The Comptroller and Auditor General may appoint a primary auditor to conduct audit on his behalf and in accordance with the directions or guidelines issued by him.
- (5) The Comptroller and Auditor General or any other person so authorised in connection with the audit of accounts of the body or authority shall have the same rights, privileges and authority as the Comptroller and Auditor General has in connection with the audit of accounts of Government.
- (6) The Comptroller and Auditor General, or an officer so authorised in this regard, will communicate the results of audit to the governing body of the body or the authority. The governing body shall submit a copy of the report to the concerned Government along with its observations. The Comptroller and Auditor General or an officer so authorised in this regard, will also forward a copy of the report to the concerned Government. The Comptroller and Auditor General shall have the right to report the results of audit to Parliament or the State legislature or Union Territory legislature.
- (7) Any expenditure incurred by the Comptroller and Auditor General in connection with the audit of the body or authority, including the expenditure incurred for the services of the primary auditor, if any, shall be paid by the body or the authority to the Comptroller and Auditor General.

# 1. Guidelines for the operation of the Corpus Fund

# A. Vision

To create Corpus Fund for promotion of higher education in Avinashilingam
 Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women.

# B. Target

 Being the Government funded institution, a corpus fund of rupees twentyfive crores or as decided by the Executive Council from time to time, shall be created and maintained in the name of the institution deemed to be University.

# C. Operation and Utilization

- > Separate bank account in the name 'AIHS&HE Corpus Fund' shall be jointly operated by the Registrar and the Finance Officer of the Institute.
- Part of this amount would be through surplus generated out of self-generated revenues. The balance would be through donations from business houses, Philanthropists and the Institute Alumni in India and abroad.
- In case of contributions received from abroad, provision of relevant law and the guidelines issued by GOI/RBI in this regard shall be followed.
- Funds generated towards Corpus Fund shall be invested in Government Securities, Bonds and Debentures of registered companies and Financial Institutions under Company's Act 1956 of fixed deposits in nationalized banks, as per the guidelines issued by Government of India and the Executive Council of the Institute from time to time subject to the approval of the Authorities.
- The interest accrued on the corpus fund shall be used only for the purpose of further development of the institution deemed to be University to the extent not supported by the grant from the Ministry of Education, Government of India.
- Expenditure shall be incurred only to meet the stated objectives as specified in the Memorandum of Association of the Institute.
- ➤ It shall be ensured that no amount of Grant-in-Aid received from Central/ State Government or any other Government Agencies shall be transferred to Corpus Fund.
- Financial status of Corpus Fund shall be depicted in the Annual Accounts of the Institute as per the guidelines of Institute.
- ➤ The accounts shall be audited every year by a Chartered Accountant or by the Auditors appointed by the Executive Council.



# 2. Guidelines for the operation of the General Fund:

- ➤ The source of income for this account shall be the excess of income over expenditure transferred from Research & Consultancy Fund, Student Deposit Fund, Student Fund, Online Account, etc apart from the interest income earned out of this account.
- Transactions related to collection of funds by way of contributions and donations from other institutions and philanthropists, CSR Fund, etc., for the development of the Institute shall be accounted.
- > In case of contributions received from abroad, provision of relevant law to be followed.
- ➤ If the money is given for a specific earmarked purpose, it must be utilized for that purpose only unless the Vice Chancellor decides otherwise and with the necessary consent of the donating member.
- > Transactions related to the capital expenditure for enhancing the academic infrastructure such as buildings, Scientific & Laboratory Equipments, Audio Visual Equipments, Computer & Peripherals, Library Books & Scientific Journals etc., and non-salary expenditure such as Repair & Maintenance shall be operated in this account.
- ➤ The account shall be jointly operated by the Registrar and the Finance Officer of the Institute.
- > The accounts shall be audited every year by a Chartered Accountant or Auditors appointed by the Executive Council.



# 3. ENDOWMENT FUND

# Guidelines for operation of the Endowment Fund

# **Introduction:**

Endowment funds are those funds which have been received with a stipulation from the contributor/donor that the amount received should not be used for any purpose other than specified by the donor. Only the income earned from these funds can be used either for general purposes of the Institute or for specific purposes, depending on the terms of the contribution made. Usually, the amount received is invested outside the educational institutions as per the terms of the contribution, if any.

The endowment is structured so that the principal amount is kept intact while the investment income is available for use, which allows for their donation to have an impact over a longer period than if it were spent all at once. An endowment may come with stipulations regarding its usage.

# Operation and Utilization:

- > The University shall accept endowments in four categories as follows.
  - Endowments for medals and cash award
  - Endowments for Lectures
  - Endowments for Student Centered Activities
  - Endowment for Bursary/ Student Scholarship
  - Endowment for Chairs / Chair Professorships

The minimum acceptable amount for the above endowments shall be as follows.

- Rs.25,000 and above for the medals and cash awards
- Rs.2,00,000 and above for Endowment Lectures. Further, the yearly interest accrued from this endowment shall be used to provide TA/DA and honorarium to the guest lectures. The other expenses like local transport, food, accommodation and other miscellaneous expenses to be met from the Institute Fund.

- Rs.1,00,000 and above for Students Centered Activities like conducting/ participating competitions at different levels.
- Rs.1,00,000 and above for Students, Bursary/ Scholarship.
- ❖ Apart from the above, Department wise Endowment Funds may be created with the permission of authorities with an Endowment fund of Rs.1,00,000/- and above for the development of the curriculum activities of that particular Department
- ➤ The funds prescribed as above donated by the donors for creations of the endowments, for award of medals, etc shall be accepted and the endowments shall be created immediately with the approval of the Vice-Chancellor.
- ➤ Funds generated towards Endowment Fund shall be deposited in the designated account as per the guidelines issued by Government of India and Executive Council from time to time.
- ➤ The interest income generated during the year shall be apportioned among the various endowment funds at the end of the Financial Year, on the basis of opening balances at the beginning of the year.
- ➤ In case of contributions received from abroad, provision of relevant law to be followed.
- > Expenditure shall be incurred only to meet the stated objectives as specified by the donor and as per the guidelines of the Institute.
- ➤ Financial status of Endowment Fund shall be depicted in the Annual Accounts of the Institute as per the guidelines of Institute.
- > Separate bank account in the name 'AIHS&HE Endowment Fund' shall be jointly operated by the Registrar and the Finance Officer of the Institute
- ➤ The accounts shall be audited every year by a Chartered Accountant or Auditors appointed by the Executive Council.



# 4. Guidelines for the operation of the Avinashilingam Working Lunch Scheme

- > The account is maintained for the transactions related to the working lunch scheme provided to the needy students of the Institute.
- > The donations/contributions received for the specific purpose of providing free lunch to the deserving students are accounted. The expenses related to the lunch provided to the students are met out of this fund.
- > The account shall be jointly operated by the Registrar and the Finance Officer of the Institute.
- > The accounts shall be audited every year by a Chartered Accountant or Auditors appointed by the Executive Council.

# 5. Guidelines for the operation of the Alumni Fund

- > Transactions related to collection of funds by way of subscriptions, contributions and donations from Alumnae for the development of the Institute shall be accounted.
- ➤ The funds collected may be invested in Government Securities, Bonds and Debentures of registered companies and Financial Institutions under Company's Act 1956 of fixed deposits in nationalized banks, subject to the approval of the Authorities.
- ➤ If the money is given for a specific earmarked purpose, it must be utilized for that purpose only unless the Executive Council decides otherwise with the advice of the Vice Chancellor and with the necessary consent of the donating member.

- > The account shall be jointly operated by the Registrar and the Finance Officer of the Institute.
- > The accounts shall be audited every year by a Chartered Accountant or Auditors appointed by the Executive Council.



# 6. Guidelines for the operation of the Curriculum Research & Consultancy Fund

- ➤ The transactions related to transfer of Institute overheads earned out of projects, Conference/Seminar/Workshops, income generated from E-studio, Institute Laboratories, Consultancy Services, etc., are maintained in this account.
- ➤ The excess of Income earned over the expenditure out of this Account as on 31st March of every year shall be transferred @ 15% to Corpus Fund and @ 85% to General Fund Account in order to augment the Corpus Fund and the infrastructure facilities by spending from General Fund Account.
- > The account shall be jointly operated by the Registrar and the Finance Officer of the Institute.
- ➤ The accounts shall be audited every year by a Chartered Accountant or Auditors appointed by the Executive Council.

# 7. Guidelines for the operation of the Students Deposits Account:

- > Transactions pertaining to the Caution Deposits of Students shall be maintained in this account.
- The transactions related to the year-wise /course-wise deposits collected and refunded shall be maintained promptly.
- ➤ The excess of Income earned over the expenditure out of this Account as on 31st March of every year shall be transferred @ 15% to Corpus Fund and @ 85% to General Fund Account in order to augment the Corpus Fund and the infrastructure facilities by spending from General Fund Account.
- > The account shall be jointly operated by the Registrar and the Finance Officer of the Institute.
- > The accounts shall be audited every year by a Chartered Accountant or Auditors appointed by the Executive Council.



# 8. Guidelines for the operation of the Students Fund Account:

- ➤ Transactions related to the Curriculum Enrichment Fee such as, Campus Development Fee, Infrastructure Maintenance, Field Trips, Special Course Fee, Personality Re-engineering Fee, Research and Development Fee, Computer Lab Fee, Sports and Tournament Fee, Youth Red Club, University Events, Soft Skills/Communication Skills, Internet, Leadership Camp, Internship Fee, etc., which are collected from the students to meet some specific expenses for the purpose for which they are collected shall be maintained in this account.
- ➤ The excess of Income earned over the expenditure out of this Account as on 31st March of every year shall be transferred @ 15% to Corpus Fund and @ 85% to General Fund Account in order to augment the Corpus Fund and the infrastructure facilities by spending from General Fund Account.
- > Expenditure during a particular semester / year is based on the receipts for that year and not on anticipatory basis.
- > The account shall be jointly operated by the Registrar and the Finance Officer of the Institute.
- ➤ The accounts shall be audited every year by a Chartered Accountant or Auditors appointed by the Executive Council.



# 9. Guidelines for the operation of the Online Account:

- > Transactions related to Collection of various fees from students such as Admission fee, Tuition Fee, Examination Fee, Caution Deposit, etc shall be maintained in this account.
- ➤ The various fees collected shall be head-wise segregated and transferred to the concerned account such as Non Plan Account, School of Engineering, Self Finance Account, Student Deposit Account, Student Fund Account, Examination Fund Account, Alumni Account, etc., at the end of every month.
- ➤ The excess of Income earned over the expenditure out of this Account as on 31st March of every year shall be transferred @ 15% to Corpus Fund and @ 85% to General Fund Account in order to augment the Corpus Fund and the infrastructure facilities by spending from General Fund Account.
- ➤ The account shall be jointly operated by the Registrar and the Finance Officer of the Institute.
  - > The accounts shall be audited every year by a Chartered Accountant or Auditors appointed by the Executive Council.



# 10.School of Engineering & Self Finance Account:

For effective research and development, the Institute needs to establish a clear strategy towards securing external funding, provisioning essential research infrastructure, recruiting and mentoring top-tier research faculty, fostering collaborations and partnerships.

- > The Institute which needs large fund for sustainable growth & development, for undertaking quality research projects, establishing a portfolio approach to research project and quality research facilities, research labs, etc., enabling the development of affordable technology.
- > Apart from Aided Courses, several courses have been started with the approval of UGC under School of Engineering and Self Finance Streams.
- A nominal amount may be collected from students towards Corpus Fund/ General Fund.
- The excess of income over expenditure from these accounts shall be spent only for the sustainable growth and Development of Educational objectives of the Institute.
- > The account shall be jointly operated by the Registrar and the Finance Officer of the Institute.
  - > The accounts shall be audited every year by a Chartered Accountant or Auditors appointed by the Executive Council.

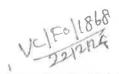

Sub: Framing of guidelines for operating the Corpus Fund, Endowment Fund and other Designated Funds - Reg.,

Ref: Note Approval by the Vice Chancellor dated 25.01.2024.

# 1. Exemption for Donations received under Sec. 80G:

It is submitted that donations made to Avinashilingam Education Trust are eligible for 50% tax exemption under Sec.80G of the Income Tax Act 1961. The copy of the letter issued by ITO is enclosed herewith.

The Income Tax Department notified that persons making donations to certain Universities/Educational Institutions of National eminence are entitled to claim 100% deduction of the donations made vide 80G (2) (a) (iiif) as per Notification in F.No.DG(E)/80G/93-94 dated 15.12.1993 of Director General (Income Tax Exemptions), Income Tax Department, Calcutta published in Part II Section 3(ii) of the Gazette of India.

This decision had been made in concurrence with the Secretary, University Grants Commission. The Notifications were issued to the individual Institutions recommended by the UGC including Gandhigram Rural Institute, Sri Sathya Sai Institute of Higher Learning, etc., The copy of the Notification is enclosed herewith.

Our Institute was declared as Deemed to be University during 1988. The aforesaid Notification was issued during 1993. Therefore, it is hoped that our Institution also would have been named in the list of exempted Universities along with Gandhigram Rural Institute.

We have requested the Income Tax authorities at Chennai, New Delhi and Kolkata time and again, officially and personally also under RTI Act 2005, in order to get the copy of the Notification and to confirm our Institute name in the list, in order to avail the 100% exemptions for the donations received. The Institute. All our attempts have proved futile as we received replies stating that the department did not have the copy of the same and could not be traced out.

We may even request the UGC to provide the list of Institutions recommended during 1993 for availing 100% exemption under 80G (2) (a) (iiif) of Income Tax Act 1961. The draft letter is enclosed herewith.
