Sri Avinashilingam Home Science College for Women was established by the great patriot and educationist Dr. T.S. Avinashilingam under the auspices of the Avinashilingam Education Trust in 1957 with 45 students. The growth of the Institution has been carefully nurtured to its current heights by the world renowned educationist and nutritionist, former Chancellor of the Deemed to be University Dr. Rajammal P. Devadas. It is now the largest Institution in the country for imparting Home Science Education at all levels. It was one of the eight colleges on which autonomy was conferred by the University of Madras in June 1978

and the first of the women's colleges to get this distinction. Autonomy gave the college scope for academic freedom for innovations in teaching and research.

The Government of India declared Sri Avinashilingam Home Science College for Women and Sri Avinashilingam Teachers College for Women as a Deemed to be University under Section 3 of the UGC Act in June 1988. These Colleges have been renamed as Avinashilingam Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women and is marching towards the thirty sixth year as a Deemed to be University.

The Institution follows the educational ideals of Sri Ramakrishna, Holy Mother Sri Saradamani Devi, Swami Vivekananda and Mahatma Gandhi and upholds a life of purity, discipline and service. A temple dedicated to Sri Ramakrishna commands the campus. Daily prayer is an integral part of campus life. All the students and staff are expected to participate in the common prayers.

The Institute functions under eight schools, namely, Home Science, Physical Sciences & Computational Sciences, Biosciences, Arts & Social Sciences, Commerce & Management, Education, Allied and Healthcare Sciences and Engineering. Each school functions under the headship of a Dean.

The pattern of education has been fully semesterised. The academic year is divided into two semesters, each semester having a minimum of 90 teaching days. The semester pattern offers each student individual attention of the teacher and facilitates all-round development of the students. It calls for active participation of the students in the learning process.

Regular attendance is an important feature of the semester pattern. In all programmes, a student requires a minimum of 75 per cent attendance for both in theory and practicals to appear for the Comprehensive Semester Examinations. Examinations for the courses offered in a semester are conducted in the same semester to make learning more effective and to reduce burden on the students.

- Provide opportunities for the all-round development of the students and excellence in higher education, research and extension in different disciplines – Home Science, Physical Sciences & Computational Sciences, Biosciences, Arts & Social Sciences, Commerce & Management, Education, Allied and Healthcare Sciences and Engineering upto the level of Ph.D.
- Inculcate ethical values, social and moral standards in all the disciplines of study
- Create awareness among women about their rights and status through adult and non-formal education
- Serve as a centre for national integration to bring together women from all parts of the country and develop an all-India perspective
- Disseminate the findings of research to the society in order to facilitate development through the community and social service programmes.

## General Information

### Library

The Institute comprises four libraries: the Central Library, located on Campus I; the School of Education Library, the School of Engineering Library and Guru Maharaj Library, which is located on Campus II. The Central Library is fully automated using **KOHA** and indigenously developed software and incorporates modern technologies to provide the right information at the right time. The well-furnished and illuminated atmosphere

supports the students in successfully pursuing their academic and research activities.

A well-planned, spacious library building with a centralized air-conditioned reading hall has a total area of 19,765 sq. ft. and 450 seating capacity. This Library has a rich collection of 2,65,256 volumes of print resources, including books, journals, theses, back volumes and non-book materials. In addition, 5,17,191 electronic resources, which include 4,86,739 e-books (Proquest, EBSCO Academic Collection, Elsevier, Springer, PHI, Wiley and Pearson), 30,444 e-journals (subscription to IEEE, EBSCO BSE) and eight e-databases (Scopus, Web of Science, EPWRF ITS, Indiatat, J-Gate, ISID, MathSciNet and DELNET) are available from e-Shodhsindhu consortium and institution subscription. The Library subscribes to



404 print periodicals, including international and national journals, magazines, gratis and newspapers. The Institute is a member of the National Digital Library of India (NDLI); the readers can access the NDLI after registering in the club and browse 107 million contents in 39 Indian languages, including the South Asia Archive and World e-Books Library.

A dynamic and efficient **website** (<https://avinuty.ac.in/library/home>) provides access to all its resources simultaneously. The subject gateway lets readers know the library resources available for specific subjects. The Library has introduced new services to augment research and learning. The Library subscribes to Grammarly, which enhances writing skills. Turnitin and Drillbit software are used to check for plagiarism. Implementation of RFID technology enables quick access to library resources and better security of library materials. Introducing the Self-service Kiosk allows the members to issue and return books by themselves. All the registered users are provided with a username and password with the help of INFLIBNET Access Management Federation (INFED) to access e-resources. The E-Resources Centre supports accessing online content from eShodhsindhu and subscription databases.

The well-equipped digital Library with 100 nodes in the central Library and libraries on the satellite campus help access the e-resources. The digitization process using D-Space software forms the institutional repository, containing rare books, theses,

Newspaper clippings, faculty publications and question papers. These digitized materials are accessed through the intranet. Photocopying, scanning and printing facilities are also available.

Print Accessibility for the Print Disabled section is formed primarily for the visually challenged with ramps, wheelchairs, assistive technologies, multimedia systems and Braille books. CCTV surveillance and fire detection alarms are available to protect the resources.

### **Library Rules**

- The Library is kept open on all days of the year except a few national holidays. The working hours are 09:00 a.m. – 08:00 p.m. on weekdays and 09:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays.
- The circulation hour is on all weekdays, Monday to Friday- from 09:00 a.m. to 05:00 p.m.
- Strict silence should be observed.
- Using Cell phones is strictly prohibited.
- Valuables should not be left at the checkpoint. The Library is not responsible for any loss of personal belongings.
- Personal books and other materials are not allowed inside.
- Users are requested to scan their identity cards while entering and leaving.
- The privilege of borrowing books is restricted to members only.
- Identity cards are a must for borrowing books. These cards are not transferable.

- Number of books borrowed varies according to the category of the members.
  - Failure to return the books on due dates will entail a fine of five rupees per book per day.
  - If any book is lost or not returned in good condition, replacement of the same book is obligatory.
  - No due certificates are provided after returning the book before the Semester Examination.
- The Institution considers theft, mutilation, or tampering with library materials, equipment, or property by users to be a serious offense.

#### **Auditorium**

The Institute has three auditoriums with modern facilities. Thiruchitrabalam Auditorium and Swami Vivekananda Auditorium in Campus-I can accommodate 2000 and 500 members respectively. Apart from these, Campus I also has an open-stage Auditorium, High Tech Seminar Hall and a huge multi-purpose hall. The Ammai Appan Auditorium in Campus-II has a seating capacity of 3000 members.

#### **Hostels**

There are six hostels, 'Kalaimagal Illam', 'Thirumagal Illam', 'Malaimagal Illam', 'Malarmagal Illam', 'Arpana Illam' and 'Poomagal Illam' with modern amenities and conveniences. There is a separate building to house the Post Graduate students and staff. Catering in the hostel is vegetarian. The mess

is run on the dividing system. Campus II has separate hostel facilities.

#### **Advanced Research Lab and Bharat Ratna Prof. C.N.R. Rao Research Centre**

Two state-of-the art Research Laboratories - Advanced Research Laboratory and Bharat Ratna Prof. C.N.R. Rao Research Centre have been established with the funding of DST under "Consolidation of University Research for Innovation and Excellence in Women Universities" (CURIE). Both these Research Centres house a wide array of highly sophisticated equipment like Field Emission Scanning Electron Microscope (FESEM), X-ray Diffractometer (XRD), Flow Cytometer, High Pressure Liquid Chromatography (HPLC), High Performance Thin Layer Chromatography (HPTLC), Nano Spray Dryer, 2D-gel Electrophoresis, Freeze Dryer, Atomic Absorption Spectrophotometer (AAS), 3D - Optical Profilometer, Fourier

Transform Infrared Spectrophotometer (FT-IR), Body Composition Analyzer, Thermo Gravimetric Analyser (TGA), Texture Analyzer, Plasma Chamber, Spectrophotometer with Color Lab, UV - Visible Spectrophotometers, Ellipsometer, and Contact Anglemeter.

The facilities of the Research centres help the research scholars and staff members of this institution to carry out advanced research activities in several disciplines spanning Home Science, Physical and Chemical Sciences, Biosciences and Health Sciences, as well as Engineering disciplines. The facilities available in both these high-technology centres are also extended to the research scholars and staff members of other educational and research institutions, at a nominal cost, as an outsourcing activity.

#### **National Cyber Defence Research Centre**

National Cyber Defence Research Centre of the Institute actively conducts several awareness programmes, workshops, seminars and allocates research projects pertaining to the cyber security area for the benefit of student community to handle cyber threats.

#### **Centre for Machine Learning and Intelligence (Campus I)**

Centre for Machine Learning and Intelligence was established in the year 2019 with the funding sponsored by Department of Science and Technology, Govt. of India. The centre revolutionizes the higher end experience for students in the process of

learning Artificial Intelligence by steering and involving them in various best practices and establish state of the art in the development and innovation of machine learning and intelligence approaches. The centre which comprises Artificial Intelligence Lab and AI Cloud centre supports and organizes various activities in collaborations with AI research groups from different fields in the Institute, promoting the interdisciplinary research.

#### **Centre for Artificial Intelligence and Robotics (Campus II)**

The Centre for Artificial Intelligence and Robotics established in the year 2019 provides a conducive environment for acquiring expertise in AI and Robotics. It also facilitates the students with opportunities and expertise for developing knowledge in AI and Robotics, implemented in early detection, diagnostics and decision making in healthcare services. It also offers a platform for research through design and development of innovative medical devices and robotics and makes them skilled personnel to address mechanisms involving AI.

#### **Career Guidance & Placement Cell**

Career Guidance & Placement Cell acts as an interface that links campus to corporates. To enhance the employment opportunities for the job-seeking candidates, it facilitates opportunities for skill development with continuous training, orientation, workshops and seminars, motivational talk by eminent speakers, insights from industry expertise etc.

To tap the entrepreneurial ideas, students are encouraged to present business proposals and are guided and facilitated to make their ideas a reality. Adequate learning resources are available to scale up the skills. The ultimate aim is to reach out to the unreachable, to benefit and contribute equally to the growth of any organization the students are associated with, and be a person of value to the society.

#### **Entrepreneurship Development Cell**

Entrepreneurship Development Cell sponsored by AICTE, New Delhi promotes entrepreneurship and encourages the students to take up Entrepreneurship as an alternative career option. Entrepreneurship Awareness Camps sponsored by Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India (EDI, India), Gujarat are conducted to create awareness among students on Entrepreneurship and provide opportunities to meet successful entrepreneurs in different fields.

### Other Scholarships

## General Rules & Regulations

**All students shall abide by the rules and regulations laid down for their discipline and development**

3. Students are required to participate in assembly prayer and in all the activities and functions of the Institute and observe order at all times. Absenting on such occasions will be considered as misconduct.
4. Organising meetings, entertainments and collecting money for any purpose in the campus without the permission of the Registrar are prohibited.
5. Students should read the notice boards carefully everyday.
6. Visitors are not allowed during working hours.
7. Students and parents should not tip the workers of the Institute. If they desire, they can deposit their gifts in the Workers' Fund maintained in the Office.
8. All students are expected to be in the premises of the Institute during the working hours.
9. Day scholars should not undertake any transactions on behalf of students in the hostel. They are not permitted in the hostel premises.
10. The Institute does not entertain any letter or other postal transactions on behalf of the day scholars.
11. Discipline needs to be observed in class rooms and campus.
12. Students must have put in a minimum of 75 percent attendance in all subjects put together to be eligible to appear for all the papers of the semester examination.
13. All applications for leave must be submitted to the Deans one week in advance except in case of illness or other unforeseen causes. Leave applications should be written in the prescribed format and duly attested by parents / guardians / warden and they should be submitted to the Deans through the Head of the Department by the end of the week.
14. When a student represents the Institute in Sports, NCC, NSS, Academic related activities etc., during the test period and thereby misses any test the average mark for the tests performed will be taken, provided she submits the permission letter in time.

15. Parents will be informed about the class performance and behaviour of their wards, as and when the need arises. They are required to write to the Registrar acknowledging receipt of all the communications, explaining the steps taken by them to rectify the situation.
16. Results of all semester examinations will be hosted in the website [www.avinuty.ac.in](http://www.avinuty.ac.in).
17. All requests for seasonal and other educational travel concessions by train or plane from bonafide students must be made to the Deans during the period which will be specified on the notice board. Request for signing concession forms will not be entertained during any other period. Concessions are available only for journeys to and from the home address specified in the application forms for admission. The outward journey should be undertaken only after the date of completion of the examinations.
18. Parents and Guardians must notify changes in their address promptly. They must inform the Registrar within two weeks when their wards discontinue their studies.
19. Those who apply for Transfer and Conduct Certificates must indicate :
  - a. the year and the class last studied
  - b. the class teacher's name
  - c. the purpose for which certificates are required and
  - d. the address to which certificates are to be sent
20. **Candidates are requested to take sufficient number of attested copies of their certificates before submitting the originals in the office. After admission the original certificates will be returned to the students in the first week of August**
21. Students who leave after the first semester will be required to pay tuition and other fees due for both the semesters.
22. The Registrar has the right to ask any student to leave the Institute and issue Transfer Certificate at any time during the course of the year for indiscipline, unauthorised absence and non-payment of fees and dues.
23. **Disciplinary action will be taken if a student involves in malpractice during Continuous Internal Assessment Tests and Comprehensive Semester Examinations.**

## **Rules & Regulations for using Mobiles and Laptops inside the Institute Campus**

- Mobile phones, laptops must be used only for the purpose of education
- Use of phones, cameras, etc., is prohibited during the class hours inside the campus. If found in contravention, they will be confiscated
- Mobile phones are strictly prohibited inside the library and examination hall
- The students should not use mobile phones while attending meetings, workshops, functions and other activities of the Institute
