REPORT ON CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMME ON


"NAVIGATING THE NIRF LANDSCAPE: PATHWAYS TO HIGHER EDUCATION EXCELLENCE"






The program began with a heartfelt prayer song, sung by Revathi Unni K, a Research Scholar in the Department of Zoology.




Dr. K.S. Santhy, Deputy Dean, School of Biosciences, and Professor of Zoology, welcomed the gathering.
