The advertisement for the recruitment of 77 Teaching and 14 Non-Teaching Posts including regular and backlog vacancies under reservation category was published in 'The Hindu' dated 29.12.2021 and also uploaded in the UGC portal on 29.12.2021, adhering to the UGC regulations and reservation norms. The last date for the receipt of the applications was 28.01.2022. Thereafter, the UGC informed vide its Letter No: F.No.1-1/2013(DU) dated 10th June, 2022 that, in view of the spirit of the MoE's letter dated 29.05.2015, there was no justification for recommending the positions due to the financial implication to the UGC /MoE.

Regarding Statutory posts of Registrar, Finance Officer, Controller of Examinations and Assistant Controller of Examinations, an advertisement calling for applications was published on 12.04.2023 with the last date of submission as 11.05.2023. Due to unforeseen delays, the process of recruitment could not be completed within the stipulated period of six months.

ii. Certification Audit:
