


Milestone Event

The Executive Council unanimously approved the Guidelines for Academic Stakeholders on Social Media Use.

Item No.06(143rd EC/2025/06) - To consider and approve the nomenclature change and upgradation of Bacteriology Lab to Probiotic Research Centre

Bacteriology Lab requires renaming as Probiotic Centre on the basis of following aspects. Bacteriology Lab is facilitated with equipment such as Laminar Air Flow Chamber (Basic Model), Autoclave, Incubator, Hot Air Oven and basic Light Microscopes. The Lab has long been used to carry out basic experiments such as total plate counts, Gram staining and motility of bacteria restricted to bio safety level-1 (BSL-1) for good bacteria alone. The name of Bacteriology Lab necessitates the analysis of all kinds of bacteria (including harmful bacteria) from clinical aspect and other aspects also, with the requirement of bio-safety cabinet and other bio-safety measures.

During the last two years, the exploration in the Lab has also been extended to the recent thrust area on Probiotics, which are beneficial bacteria pertaining to BSL-1. The probiotic work is focused on isolation, identification, characterization and development of probiotics for applications aligning to the present and future need of exploration of positive side of bacteria. The procedures for probiotic analysis have been standardized to offer income generated services to students from inside and outside the institution. Hence the renaming and upgrading of **Bacteriology Lab to Probiotic Research Centre** is justified based on the study and development of probiotics in the Lab with facilities for BSL-1.

Charges for Probiotic Analysis and Analytical Charges in Probiotic Research Centre as a part of income generation from the Centre are given in **Annexure – 03**.

Dr. A. Vijayalakshmi proposed and Dr. R. Shanthi seconded the motion.

The Executive Council unanimously approved the nomenclature change and upgradation of Bacteriology Lab to Probiotic Research Centre as well as the charges proposed for different tests.

Item No.07(143rd EC/2025/07) – To consider and approve the change of name from “Edible and Eco-friendly Packaging Centre” to “Eco-friendly, Edible Analysis and Packaging Centre”

Item No.08(143rd EC/2025/08) – Study Leave follow up Committee Meeting

Study Leave Follow up Committee Meeting was held on 04.08.2025 at 10.00 a.m. on the request of Assistant Professor (SS), Department of Special Education. She availed Study Leave from 25.06.2024 to 24.06.2025(One Year) and joined duty on 25.06.2025 F.N. As per UGC Gazette of India 2018 dated 18.07.2018 and its further amendments Rule 8.2 (xiii) (a) "A teacher who is unable to complete her studies within the period of study leave granted to her shall be liable to refund to the Institution, the amount of leave salary and allowances and other expenses incurred on the teacher or paid to her in connection with the course of study."

Since the candidate did not submit the Synopsis and Thesis after rejoining duty from study leave period till now, she is required to repay the salary for the period of one year in addition to 10% interest, calculated up to the date of repayment. This procedure has been followed in such instances earlier.

When the letter to repay was given regarding the salary already paid, Assistant Professor requested to place this matter to the Executive Council and she said she will obey the directives of the Executive Council in this regard. The matter is placed for the decision of the Executive Council.

It was informed by the Chairperson that this request is submitted before Executive Council as per the special request received from Assistant Professor and also explained briefly about the University Grants Commission (UGC) norms regarding this and procedure followed during the sanction of study leave.

Dr. S. Vaidhyasubramaniam recommended ensuring that this does not hinder her from finishing her studies.
