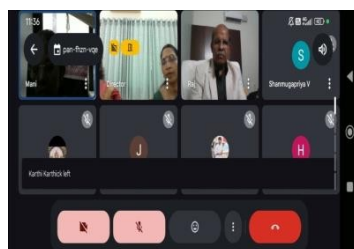

Details of activities conducted

The **Women's Studies Center** of Avinashilingam Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women and District Social Welfare Department organized event **"UNiTE to End Digital Violence against All Women and Girls"** on **"Awareness on Digital Violence"** on **November 24th, 2025** at the Government Middle and High school Theethipalayam and Government High School, Pachaipalayam.

Dr. G. Sheefna, Assistant Professor, Women's Studies Centre, Avinashilingam Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women conducted the awareness program and educated the participants on digital violence, harms caused by digital violence like physical, sexual, psychological, social and economic harm. As a preventive measure madam suggested to use strong, unique passwords for all the accounts and to be aware of what to be shared online, to avoid sharing of personal details such as address, phone number, and name of the school in public forums.

Mr. Aswath Krishna PL., Coordinator from the District **Social Welfare Department** gave a talk about the DSWD and its role in implementing Government schemes for vulnerable groups like women, children, the elderly, and differently-abled, offering services from hostels, scholarships (backward classes), and career guidance, specific aid for marriage, maternity, and disability, operating from the District Collectorate campus, focusing on legal protection and empowerment for the underprivileged. He emphasized on the Child Help Line, Women Help Line and Elderly Help Line numbers which is the need of the day.

A total of 39 students from Government High School, Pachaipalayam, participated in the programme, and students from Government Middle and High School, Theethipalayam, also benefited.

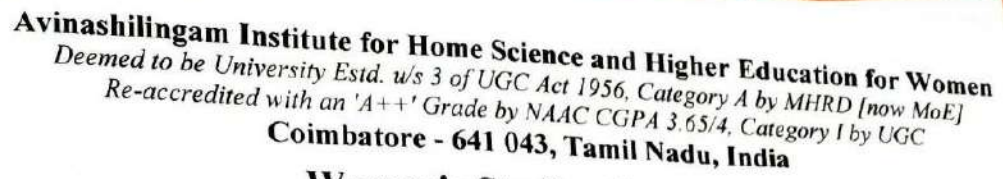

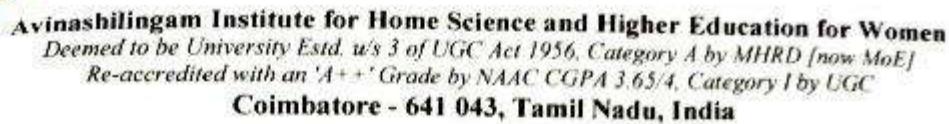

The **Women's Studies Center** of Avinashilingam Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women and District Social Welfare Department organized an event **“UNiTE to End Digital Violence against All Women and Girls”** conducted an awareness program on **“Digital Literacy to face the Digital Violence”** at the Government Higher Secondary Schools, Peelamedu, Gandhimaa Nagar, Villankurichi on November 26th, 2025.

Dr. G. Sheefna, Assistant Professor, Women's Studies Centre, Avinashilingam Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women created awareness on digital literacy which is the need of the hour particularly among the students. She insisted that digital literacy is crucial for combating digital violence by equipping individuals to recognize, report, and prevent online abuse, to promote critical thinking to expose misinformation, and empower the students to build safer online interactions which protects everyone, especially vulnerable groups like women and girls.

Mr. Aswath Krishna PL., Coordinator from the District **Social Welfare Department** gave a talk about the Government schemes for vulnerable groups like women, children, the elderly, and differently-abled. He emphasized awareness on the Child, Women and Elderly numbers. He also highlighted about the Government schemes related to women and children, namely the scheme **“Sathiyavanimuthu Ammaiya Ninaivu Free Supply of Sewing Machine Scheme”** which provides free sewing machines to eligible widows and destitute women. The students whose mothers were single were given the contact numbers to apply for the scheme.

Totally **116 students** of Government Higher Secondary Schools from Peelamedu, Gandhimaa Nagar, Villankurichi benefitted.

<u>Details of activities conducted</u> <p>The Women's Studies Center of Avinashilingam Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women and District Social Welfare Department organized event “UNiTE to End Digital Violence against All Women and Girls” at Government Higher Secondary Schools, Venkatapuram on November 28th, 2025.</p> <p>Dr. G. Sheefna, Assistant Professor, Women's Studies Centre, Avinashilingam Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women spoke on the Technology Facilitated Gender Based Violence (TFGBV). Defining TFGBV as an act of violence committed, assisted by the use of information and communication technologies or digital media, against a person because of their gender. Madam highlighted on understanding this form of violence that is rooted in our society including physical harm and psychological distress. She explained a wide range of abusive behaviors such as image-based sexual abuse, cyber harassment, stalking, doxxing, hate speech, gender trolling, hacking and sextortion.</p> <p>Mr. Aswath Krishna PL., Coordinator from the District Social Welfare Department gave a talk about the scholarships for students including Post-Matric and Pre-Matric schemes. The Scholarships were given for the Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST) and converted Christians from Scheduled Castes (SCC). The other scholarships were for Backward Caste (BC), Most Backward Caste (MBC) and Denotified Communities (DNC) students were also informed. 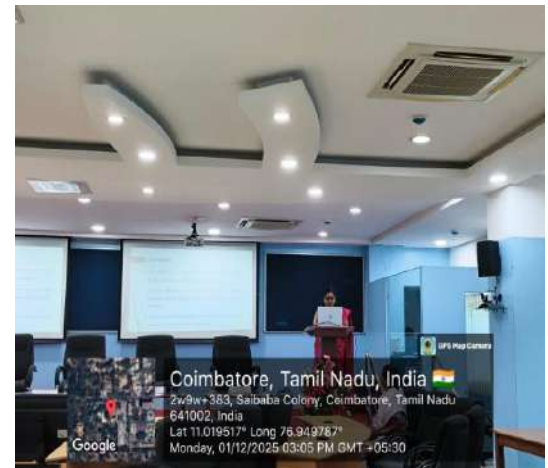

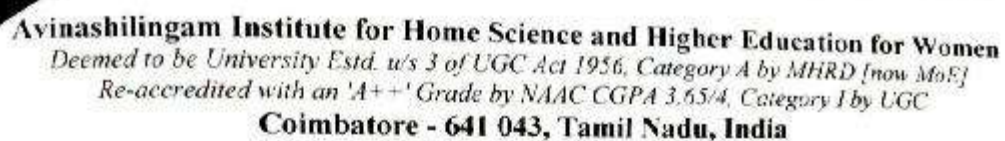
