
Objectives

The hands-on session on Mendeley aimed to:

- 1. Introduce Mendeley as a reference management tool.
- 2. Familiarize the participants with the features and functionalities of Mendeley.
- Guide the participants on how to download and install then create and manage their Mendeley accounts.
- 4. Help the participants understand how to import, organize, and cite references using Mendeley.

Method

The hands-on session on Mendeley was conducted on 8th May 2023 at School of Education. Total 25 participants attended the session included researchers and faculty members from school of Education. The session started with a brief introduction to Mendeley, its features,



and benefits. The resource person showed how to download the Mendeley from proper source and demonstrate the step by step installation. Duration of the workshop was 1 hour.

The trainer then demonstrated how to create a Mendeley account, import references from different sources, organize them into folders, and cite those using different referencing styles.

The participants were operated the Mendeley site with their own laptops based on the instructions given by the trainer. They were encouraged to explore the various features of Mendeley and ask questions. The session was continued to how to add references manually with article title, author name, and with DOI number.




Figure 2: Adding the references manually


The trainer also guided the participants on how to use Mendeley's social networking features to connect with other researchers and discover new research articles.
