Report on the Two-day workshop On 'Manuscript Preparation and Submission' for Research Scholars

About the Workshop:

A two-day interactive workshop on 'Manuscript Writing and Submission' was organized for the Ph.D. research scholars of the School of Physical Sciences and Computational Sciences (PSCS). The workshop is a research mentoring workshop organized to enhance the research scholars' manuscript writing skills and to facilitate them to publish their manuscripts in suitable journals. Dr.T.Prem Kumar, Senior Principal Scientist (Formerly), CECRI, Professor, CSIR Academy of Scientific and Innovative Research, was the resource person for the workshop. **Sixty** Ph.D. research scholars of the School of PSCS, 20 from computer science, 17 from mathematics, 16 from chemistry, and 7 from physics, participated in the workshop.

The highlights of the workshop are:

It is a well-conceived workshop with three orientation sessions prior to the workshop to orient the scholars to prepare the manuscript.

The scholars were asked to prepare the manuscripts and to identify indexed journals in their domains in which they could submit their manuscripts. The coordinators from each department helped them in the selection of journals from the latest list of Web of Science journals shared by the Deputy-Dean.

The scholars were asked to find suitable references in their relevant domains from the Scopus publications of the University.

At the end of the workshop, about 24 research scholars submitted their manuscripts for plagiarism and were ready to upload their papers to journals.

Day 1, Thursday 21.08.2022

The resource person Dr.T.Prem Kumar, Senior Principal Scientist (Formerly), CECRI, Professor, CSIR Academy of Scientific and Innovative Research, in his first session on 'Getting Published' clearly explained the step-by-process a scholar should follow while writing the manuscript to improve the chances of publication. He elaborated on how to phrase the title for the research paper, the importance of conflict of research interest, and the format of the cover letter to the editor of the journal. This session provided a comprehensive review of research paper writing, starting from abstract to reference.

In the afternoon session, Dr.T.Prem Kumar elaborated on the topic 'A Brush with Grammar' in which he clearly explained how to write manuscripts without grammatical errors.

Valedictory Session:



that the workshop outcome is that 24 scholars prepared their manuscripts that are ready for journal submission.


Feedback on the Workshop Proceedings




Give your feedback on Resource Lecture #2: "A brush with Grammar"




