1. PENCIL SKETCHING:

Theme - 'Need for Breastmilk Bank'

- All sketches must reflect the given theme.
- Sketches must be created using pencils only, Use of colored pencils is allowed but avoid other mediums like ink, markers, or paints.
- Sketches must be done on an A3 sheet, Only one side of the sheet should be used.



2. CROSSWORD/PUZZLES:

Theme - 'Breastmilk - Holistic Feed for Infants'

- All crossword puzzles must be related to the given theme.
- Each puzzle must contain a minimum of 15 questions. Attach an answer key with the submission.
- Puzzles must be hand-drawn and neatly presented in A4 Sheet.



3. FLIP CARDS:

Theme - Health Benefits of Breastmilk to Mother'

- All flip cards must relate to the given theme.
- Each set must contain a minimum of 10 cards, Cards should be of uniform size (Post Card Size 14×9 cm).
- Each card should have a question or fact on the front and the answer or explanation on the back.
- Images or diagrams are encouraged but must be appropriate and relevant.
- Cards must be hand-drawn and neatly presented. Use durable Material.



4. E - POSTER MAKING:

Theme - 'Why Breastmilk to Infant?


- All E-posters must reflect the given theme.

- Ensure the design is original and not copied from other sources.
- Each participant can submit only one E-poster.

Theme - 'Awareness on BreastFeeding'

- Videos must reflect the given theme.
- The video should be a maximum of 3 minutes in length.
- The video file size should not exceed 75 MB.
- Each participant can submit only one video.

6. RECIPE BOOKLET:

Theme - 'Traditional Recipes for Lactating Mothers'

- All recipes must relate to healthy and nutritious recipes suitable for the given theme.

- Each recipe card should be A5 size (half the size of an A4 sheet).
- Each participant must submit a minimum of 10 recipes.
- Each card should include the recipe title, ingredients, preparation method, and relevant nutritional information.
- Recipes can be handwritten or printed but must be neatly presented.
