About the Library

The Central Library, located at the heart of the campus and spanning 19,765 sq. ft., features a centrally air-conditioned reading hall with seating for 450 users. Fully automated with KOHA and custom-developed software, it offers seamless access to an extensive collection of print and electronic resources (7,99,826). As a proud member of ONOS, the library provides 24/7 remote access to its digital resources. To support academic and research needs, the library offers tools for grammar checking, plagiarism detection and citation databases. The library is designed to be inclusive, it is equipped with ramps, wheelchairs, assistive technologies, multimedia systems, and Braille books. Security and safety are ensured through RFID, CCTV surveillance and advanced fire safety systems.

About the Seminar

The national seminar aims to engage administrators, faculty members, research scholars, and students in discussing the ethical use of AI tools in academic publishing. It focuses on promoting ethical AI practices during the early stages of research, leveraging AI for literature searches, addressing challenges to research integrity arising from AI, and ensuring the ethical streamlining of the publishing workflow.

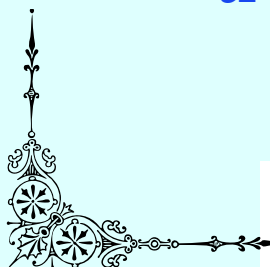
